

Pre-Appointment Instructions

We look forward to meeting you and helping in anyway we can. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to call us.

- Please register online to save 15-30 minutes before your appointment.
- Please bring your referral information from your general dentist.
- All patients under the age of 18 must be accompanied on each visit by their parent or legal guardian.
- Continue all routine medication for blood pressure, diabetes, thyroid problems, and any other conditions as recommended by your physician. However, do not take medication for discomfort (i.e. Ibuprofen, Advil, Motrin, Aleve, etc.) prior to the first visit because it may mask symptoms and hinder a diagnosis.
- Eat breakfast or lunch before your appointment to ensure a normal blood glucose level.
- If you require prophylactic antibiotics before any dental visit for a prosthetic heart valve or orthopedic prosthesis (artificial hip, knee, elbow, etc), please call our office for instructions. If you have already discussed this with us, you do not need to call again.
- The procedure will be performed using local anesthesia. There are usually no restrictions after the procedure concerning driving or returning to work. However, if oral sedation will also be used, you will need someone to escort you to and from our office and you should not return to work for the remainder of the day.
- Insurance: Endodontic fees are based on the complexity of the procedures. We will make every effort to help you get reimbursed by your insurance carrier. Payment is due at the time of service. We welcome any questions you may have about payments and insurance benefits.
